- > Currently the role of the Shared Care Coordinator sits under the Midwifery Unit Manager of AWHS:
- > 2 days per week otherwise MUM
- Antenatal, Gynaecology, GynaeOncology, Colposcopy, Urodynamics, clinics across 3 sites
- Antenatal Education
- Termination Services

- Maternity Outreach
- Shared Care Co-Ordinator
- > Liaise with GP about abnormal results.
- > Book women before 20 weeks and again at 36 & 40 weeks.
- > Arrange anti-D to be sent out




Models of care offered at first visit.

Referral Pathways






Following first visit

- Southern Links program (DASSA, PNMH, Social work..)
- Obstetric Medicine
- Perinatal mental health nurse
- If GP S/C and negative blood group MUM sends record to transfusion who send out anti-D at 28/34 weeks once they have phoned the practice.
- > Monthly stats about bookings and births are sent to GP Partners.
